TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF GLENEAGLE GOLD-PLEASE HELP US

Dear Shareholder,

We are the Traditional Owners of the Country at Fortnum where this Company is carrying out major exploration and mining activity. We are the first group in WA to have our native title recognised back in 2000.

We have tried for many months to make a protective heritage sites and environmental management agreement with this company but it still refuses to do so. This is even when it *must* make an agreement with us, which is a binding condition on its tenements.

We are very saddened and upset at the company's approach-it just comes onto our Country and does as it pleases. We are concerned that the Company may have already destroyed our sites. If this is found to be so, the Company and its directors can be prosecuted for a criminal offence with big fines and perhaps jail for any wrongdoers.

We are not opposed to mining and exploration on our Country, provided important places are protected-we have made good "win/win" agreements with other companies, large and small, that everyone agrees work well and efficiently. We have attached our latest Jidi Jidi letter sent to Ian Prentice. This and other information has of necessity been sent out to the world community to see and to get support for our struggle to get this company to do the right thing and to let them know what is happening on our Country.

We will continue to protect our Country and let the world know what is happening until an agreement is reached.

At the 15 March General Meeting, as one of the major owners of this Company, please ask the Board to do the right thing and enter into our agreement with us so that this fighting on our Country can end at last.

My daughters have told me and the other Elders of what happened at their meeting with you in Perth.

They told us of how you said on one hand you wanted to protect our heritage places and yet on the other hand flat refused to even consider negotiation of our heritage agreement that protects our heritage. We have given this agreement to you many months ago and other companies have signed it and have found it to be a good, workable, fair agreement.

~~This is shameful Ian-you know that your company is doing exploration activity on our Traditional Lands without our consent, without our agreement.~~


Do you not care what we think? You are supposed to be a welcome guest on our Country but you are just ignoring our wishes as the recognised Traditional owners.

Sadly the fighting between us will now have to continue Ian. This is not our choice but a choice forced on us by you.

We will never give up protecting our Country. The constant effort in trying to get you to do the right thing on our Country is wearing us Old People down now after all this time, but our children will keep up the Battle for us.

We cannot stand by and let you destroy our Country without our protections in place as that is our obligation to our Ancestors and to our children Ian.

We ask that you reconsider your decision and start the negotiations on our agreement. Let us know your answer very soon Ian.
